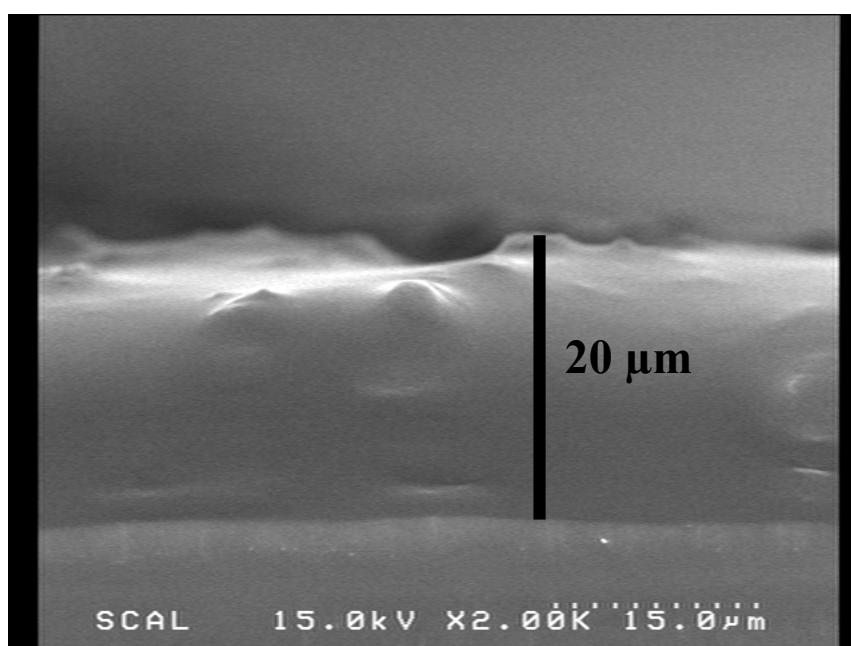

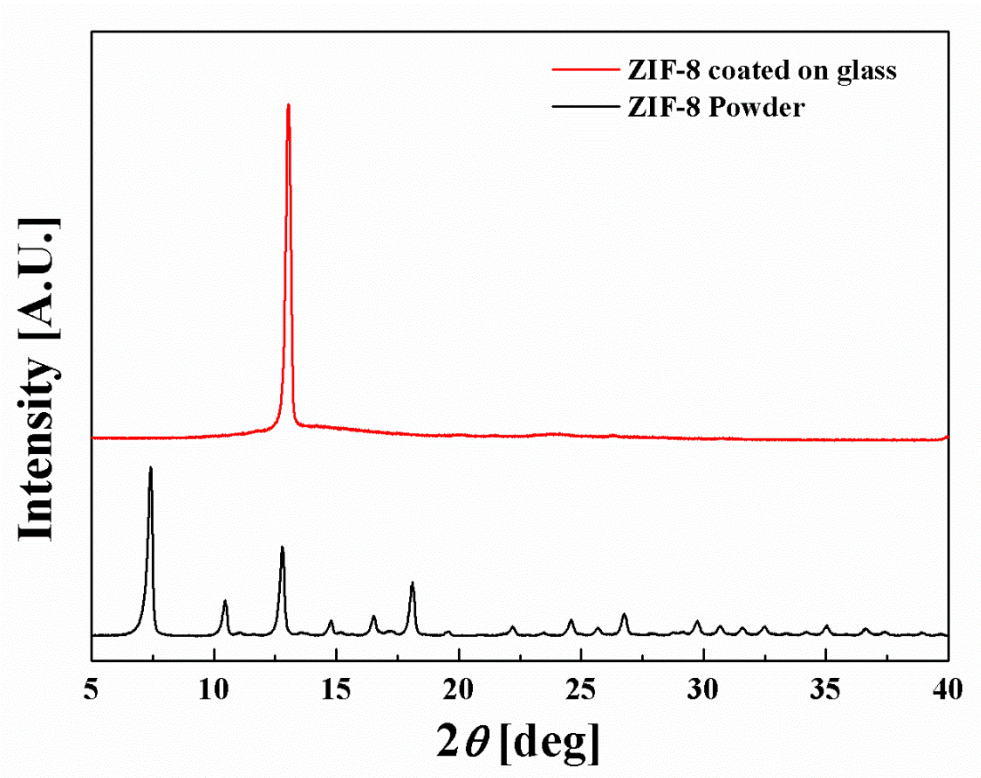


Figure S2. XRD pattern of ZIF-8 coated on glass with DMF in solution
