We are pleased to announce that the 4<sup>th</sup> Oxford Tidal Energy Workshop, OTE2015, will be held in Oxford on the 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of March, 2015. OTE2015 builds on three successful workshops to provide opportunities for scientists, engineers, and researchers to discuss technical issues in tidal stream power generation. Topics may include, but are not limited to:

- Device-scale problems (hydrodynamics, design, fluid-structure interaction, etc)
- Array-scale problems (wake interaction, array optimisation, etc)
- Basin-scale problems (resource assessment, environmental impact, etc)
- Novel experimental, computational, and theoretical approaches for tidal energy research

We endeavour to ensure all accepted abstracts will be timetabled for oral presentation, however some may be allocated to poster sessions.
